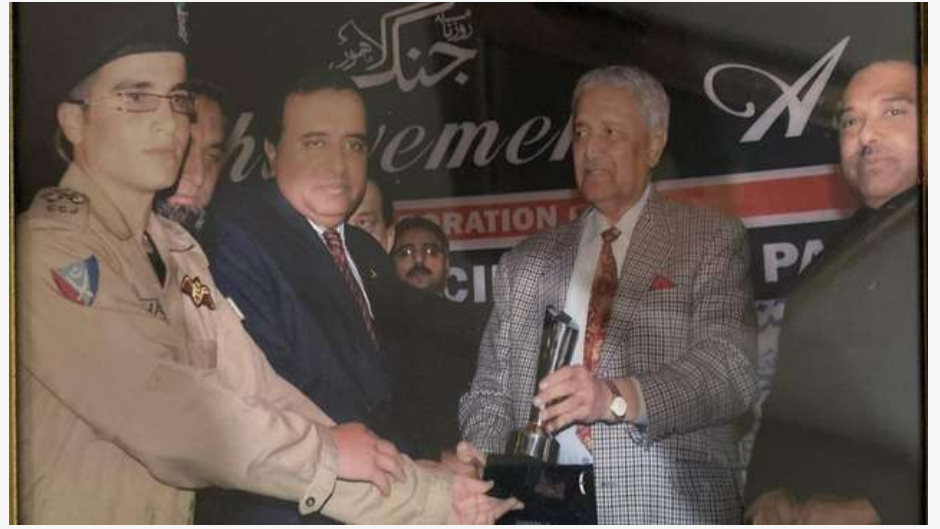

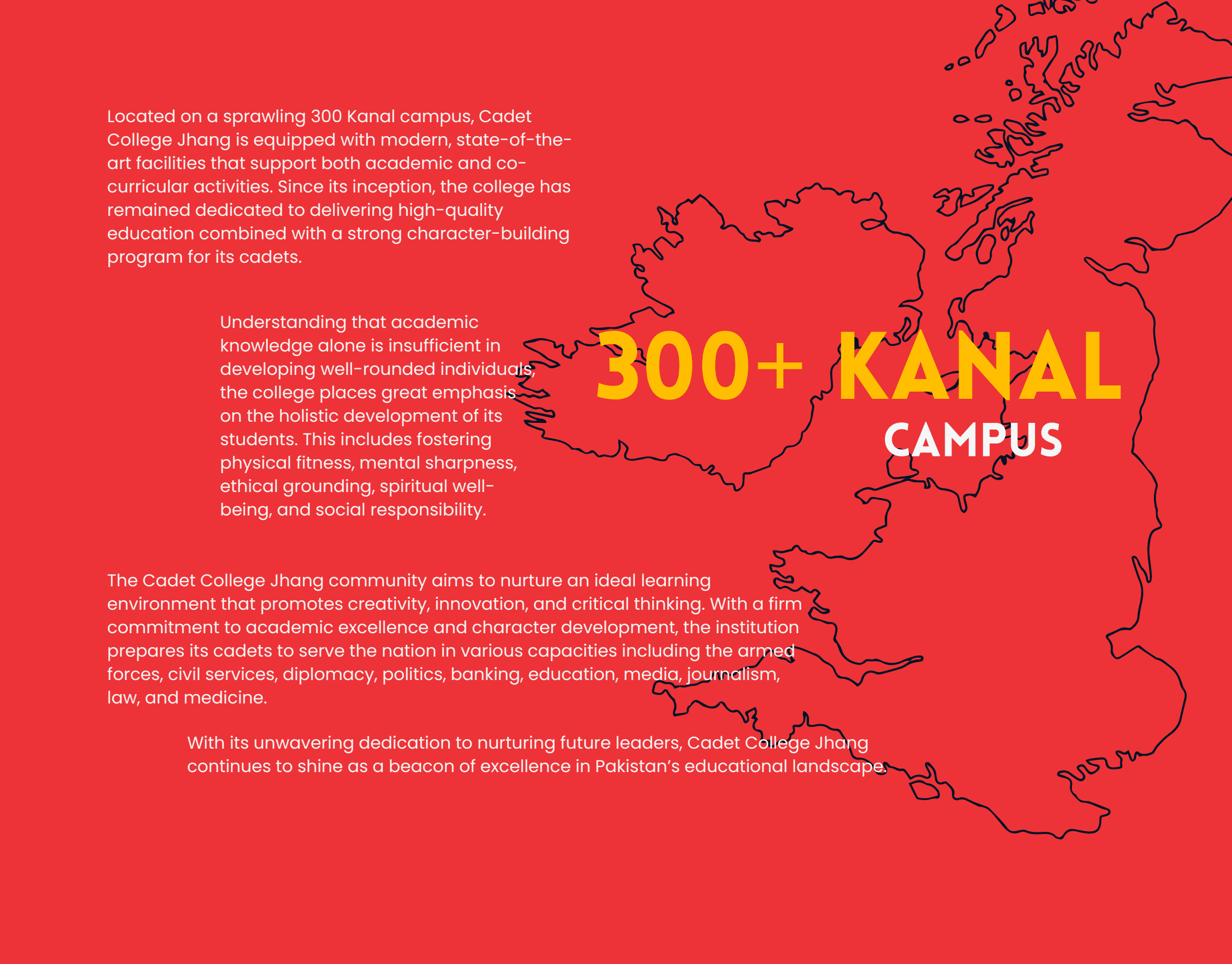

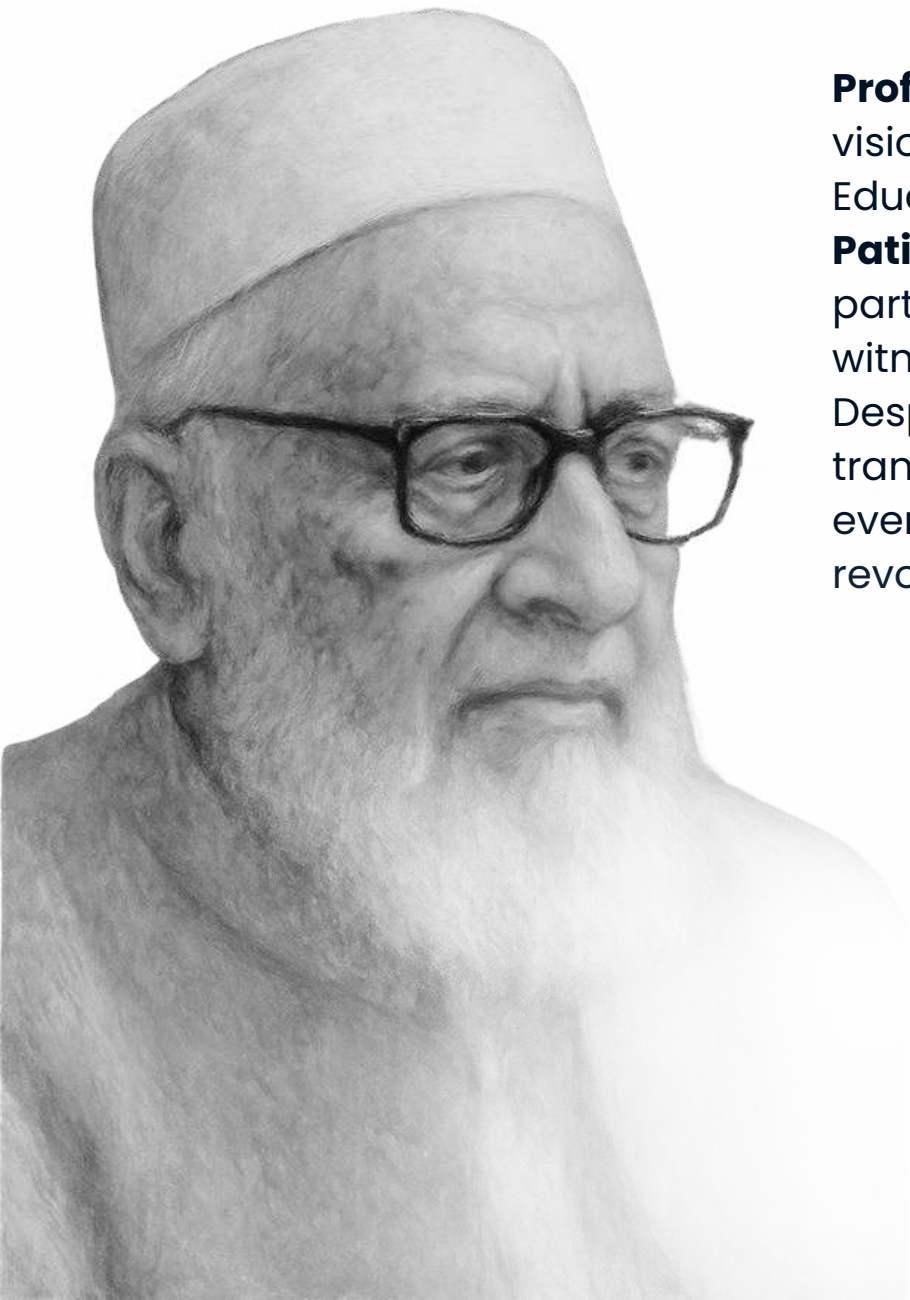

FOUNDER CADET COLLEGE JHANG



Professor Khurshid Muhammad Gauhar Siddiqui was a visionary educationist and the founder of the Imam Ghazali Education System and Cadet College Jhang. Born in **Patiala, India**, his life was forever changed by the 1947 partition; at age 12, he survived a bullet wound and witnessed the martyrdom of his father and infant brother. Despite a journey marked by poverty and displacement, he transformed his trauma into a mission of national service, eventually settling in Jhang to lead an educational revolution.

His philosophy was a unique blend of modern scientific excellence and Islamic values, aiming to produce professionals—doctors, engineers, and officers—who were also "conscious and practicing Muslims." Over 64 years of tireless effort, he expanded a small tuition center into a network of over 25 institutions, mentoring more than 80,000 students worldwide. In 1998, he ensured his legacy by calling his eldest son, Commander Suhaib Farooq, to retire from the Navy and take the helm. Today, his work remains a profound Sadaqah Jariya, continuing to shape the "eagles" of Pakistan.

Suhaib Farooq is a retired **Lieutenant Commander of the Pakistan Navy** and a professional pilot who served as a General Duty Pilot until his retirement in 1998. Holding a BSc (Hons) in Aerospace, he was a qualified pilot on eight different aircraft and completed an instructor pilot course in the United Kingdom. Following his military service, he transitioned into a prominent educational and social entrepreneur, establishing the Imam Ghazali Education System, which consists of 24 schools in remote areas, and founding both Cadet College Jhang and Pakistan's first Girls Cadet College. His commitment to education and national service is further evidenced by his role as a National Security Think Tank member and his graduation from the National Defence University's course on National Security.



Beyond education, Farooq has made significant contributions to social work, politics, and the private sector. He was awarded the "Sitara-e-Esar" by the President of Pakistan for his extensive rehabilitation efforts in earthquake-hit areas, which included rebuilding hundreds of homes and several schools and mosques. He has also been active in local and national politics, serving twice as the Nazim of Jhang. Additionally, he manages a private security company that employs over 400 retired military personnel, serves as a National Media Analyst, and holds leadership positions in organizations like the Rotary International District 3272 and the Jhang Chamber of Commerce and Industry.
