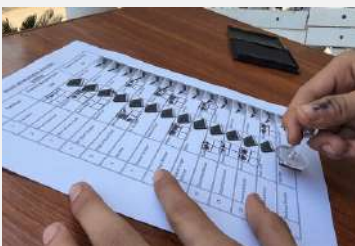

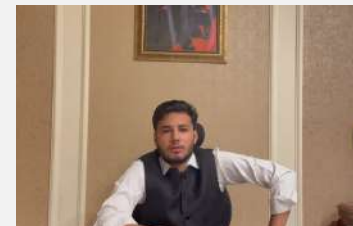
The primary objective of **Azm-e-Nau** was to rigorously test cadets' tactical skills, leadership capabilities, and decision-making under extreme stress. This critical training ensures personnel are ready for sudden, worst-case scenarios, developing a rapid and effective response to any challenge presented.

Cadet College Jhang's Azm-e-Nau exercise simulated two opposing nations, **Chaman** and **Tajistan**, challenging cadets with the realities of democracy and conflict through hands-on, vital leadership training.

Cadets gained valuable exposure to governance, diplomacy, and **political strategy** through full-scale simulations, including a highly structured **Voting Day** event and complex negotiation sessions aimed at securing consensus.



A sudden and devastating **terrorist attack** on innocent Chaman civilians tragically occurred, immediately disrupting regional stability. Crucially, this heinous act of violence was wrongly and publicly blamed on the neighboring nation of Tajistan. This wrongful attribution dramatically escalated **political tensions** and profound mistrust between the two countries, severely threatening the fragile regional peace and necessitating urgent, careful international diplomatic intervention to prevent further escalation or conflict.



At the emergency **UN meeting**, Chaman presented crucial evidence regarding the recent terrorist attack, asserting the artillery and specific weapons used belonged directly to Tajistan. However, **Tajistan firmly denied** all responsibility for the devastating incident.

They maintained the attacks were conducted by an external organization or state actor during the session. This created a profound diplomatic impasse that demands immediate and swift global attention.





The **preparation phase** leading to the final day was a grueling process, meticulously designed to execute the shift from political engagement to military readiness. This transformation demanded that cadets transition from consultative roles as statesmen into disciplined soldiers. Central to this regime was an exceptionally demanding **assault course**, engineered to test endurance and mental discipline within high-stress tactical environments.

Following this, the unit undertook a **12 km route march** toward the battlefield, carrying full combat loads to solidify their physical conditioning. Upon arrival, they executed immediate **tent settlement** for survival, establishing a secure perimeter under duress. Every drill was carefully calibrated to ensure cadets possessed the psychological fortitude necessary for deployment. This unwavering, rigorous preparation was essential, serving to harden their technical skills and operational mindset for the final confrontation and the inevitably unpredictable challenges they were destined to face.





War Day presented intense **operational challenges**, beginning with a **log collection** exercise to build functional strength. Between high-stress maneuvers, the cadets shared a brief **bonfire**, learning to relax their minds amidst the chaos. The main operational exercise then pushed them to their limits: a **high-speed run**, navigating lethal simulated **minefields**, and the grueling **dead body lifting** drill. They pushed forward through narrow trenches, **crawling in mud** and suffocating **thick dust**, before the final mission. Finally, soldiers had to find **hidden materials** in the brush, successfully concluding the war with total tactical success.



The **exercise concluded** when the terrorist group **Tehrik-e-Ehtejaj** publicly **confessed** to the initial attack, fully clearing Tajistan of blame. This resolution was made possible after experts gathered undeniable physical proofs and tactical evidence from the field. With the truth revealed, Chaman and Tajistan subsequently signed a formal **Peace Treaty**, restoring regional stability through facts and transparent diplomacy. This diplomatic success ensured that justice prevailed, solidifying a lasting and **peaceful coexistence** between both nations.
